

We will be welcoming back religious education families to the 2021/2022 school year during our **Family Night on Wednesday, September 8, at 7:00 p.m. in the church.** As part of that evening's activities, you will have an opportunity to meet the catechists and learn about the plans for the coming year. The first class for **Grades K-5 will take place on Saturday, September 11, from 9:00 to 10:30 a.m.;** classes for **Grades 6-8 will start on Wednesday, September 15, from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m.** Everyone participating in the RE Program, adults and children, will wear masks and maintain social distancing while they attend classes in our church building.

Registrations are still being taken for the 2021/2022 classes. Forms may be downloaded from our parish website st-phil.org or you can pick up a form in the literature rack in the church narthex. Please let your friends and neighbors know that preparation for First Communion is a two-year process (Grades 1 & 2), but we encourage families to start their children off by enrolling them in kindergarten to establish a good (and fun!) foundation for their faith formation. Confirmation is a mandatory three-year process starting in Grade 6 and culminating in eighth grade. Home study is not an option during the sacramental years (Grades 2 & 8).

Thank you to all of the parents for the work they did during last year's homestudy classes to continue their children's religious education during a challenging pandemic. For the past several weeks as we've journeyed through Chapter 6 of John's Gospel we've encountered Jesus as the one who can relieve physical hunger (in the feeding of the 5,000) and as the nourishment necessary for fullness of life. Today's gospel and first reading call us to make a choice, just as the people of Israel did when Joshua, shortly before his death, gathered them together in an invitation to rededicate themselves to serving the Lord. This choice is also placed before the Twelve when Jesus asks them, "Do you also want to leave?" A life of discipleship is not easy. We are called to accept teachings that are difficult and commandments that, at times, may seem impossible. Jesus asks us to love our enemies, turn the other cheek, and embrace the same vulnerability and humility that he embodied on the cross. To any one of these requests we might be tempted to say, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" And yet, Jesus reminds us today that these words, which cause consternation and challenge us to be more than we ever thought possible, are "Spirit and life."





Baptism Information: Baptisms are celebrated on the second & fourth Sunday of each month. A pre-Baptism program must be attended by the parents. Please call the rectory to register for a program.

Marriage Information: Please call the rectory to make arrangements at least six months (a year is preferred) in advance of the wedding date. It is recommended you do not rent reception facilities until your wedding date is confirmed with the pastor. Your preferred wedding date may be unavailable, and we do not want you to lose your deposit with the reception venue.

Parish Registration: New families are welcome and are asked to register at the rectory. Also, previously registered parishioners are asked to notify us of any address changes.

Emergency Sick or Anointing Calls: Please notify us immediately of any serious illness in your family. If you have a hospitalized loved one who would like a visit, please call the rectory with contact information since the hospitals and hospices no longer notify parishes. Please do not wait until the last minute to have someone anointed. There are always accidents/emergencies, but sometimes there is less panic when the anointing can be done prior to someone passing.

We now have available low-gluten hosts which make it possible for people who have celiac disease or allergies to wheat or gluten to be able to receive communion. If you have celiac disease or an allergy to wheat or gluten, please let us know before Mass so that arrangements can be made for you to be able to receive communion at Mass.


