### ***ASH WEDNESDAY (February 17, 2021)***

***Protocols & Registrations at [st-phil.org](http://st-phil.org)***

***Reservations for Ash Wednesday Masses & Prayer Services opened on Sunday, February 7.***

***Masses will be at 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.;  
prayer services will be at 12:15 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.***

- ◆ There will only be two people (the Presider and Extraordinary Minister of Communion) giving ashes at the front of the church.
- ◆ The Presider will say the prayer for blessing the ashes.
- ◆ The Presider, without saying anything, will sprinkle the ashes with Holy Water.
- ◆ The Presider will address the church ONLY ONCE as he/she says, "*Repent and believe in the Gospel*" or "*Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return.*"
- ◆ The Presider will sanitize his hands, put on his face mask and shield, and distribute ashes.
- ◆ The Presider and Extraordinary Minister of Communion will sprinkle ashes on the head of each one without saying anything. (Only a small amount of ash is sprinkled by rubbing the thumb and forefinger together over the head of the recipient.)
- ◆ Hands are then cleansed and sanitized.


**The Hound of Heaven**

In just a few days we will enter into the season of Lent: a time of preparation, penance, and purification as we look toward our holiest days of the year when we celebrate in a particular way Jesus' passion, death and resurrection. In today's gospel, a leper approaches Jesus and says, "If you wish, you can make me clean." It is interesting that the leper does not ask Jesus a question: "Can you make me clean?" Or implore him for a favor: "Will you make me clean?" Instead, he comes to Jesus with a statement of faith: "If you wish, you can make me clean." Perhaps this man has heard of

the healings of Jesus performed in Capernaum, or maybe he has an intuitive sense of Jesus' closeness to God; in any case, the leper is emboldened to name Jesus as the one who possesses power over sickness. As we prepare for the beginning of Lent on Ash Wednesday, let us take a moment to consider the broken and sinful places in our own lives and in the life of our community. What affliction—whether of mind, body or spirit—might God be calling us to turn over to him and his infinite mercy? Do we have the faith to say to Jesus, "If you wish, you can make me clean?"



### **SENIORS INVITED TO DEFER PROPERTY TAXES**

Qualified senior citizens, aged 65 years and older, are invited to apply for the Senior Citizen Real Estate Tax Deferral Program. The program allows participants to defer property tax payment until the property is sold. The deferral is treated as a loan and accrues 6% simple interest until paid. To qualify, the applicant's household income cannot exceed \$55,000. Additionally, the property must be used exclusively for residential purposes.

**The application period closes March 1, 2021.**

Please do not wait until the last minute to have someone anointed. There are always accidents/emergencies, but sometimes there is less panic when the anointing can be done prior to someone passing.

If you have celiac disease or an allergy to wheat or gluten, please let us know before Mass so that arrangements can be made for you to be able to receive communion at Mass.


