



In response to the question, "Has there ever been a time when you or someone you know felt like an outcast? How did faith and prayer help to change the situation?" Nicolas Ruberto replied, "When I was in grammar school, there was a new student who was pretty shy and had not made any friends yet. One of my friends decided to make fun of him to make everyone laugh at him. I went home and thought about what happened. It really bothered me because I know the boy felt really bad and he had no one to stick up for him. So I prayed really hard about it, and when I went to school the next day, it happened again. This time I stood next to him and said, 'This is my friend, don't say that to him!' And I became his first friend. He was so happy from that day on and we are still friends to this day." Sixth grade catechist Sal Ferenzi wrote, "Good evening Nicolas, what an amazing and enlightening story. Your parents must be very proud of you. This is exactly what Jesus would want us to do and this is also what our religion teaches us. You are doing God's work. Keep up the good work."

Joshua Ford responded to the question by talking about his experience in a sports tryout. "One time I felt like an outcast was in tryouts for baseball a couple years ago when I couldn't hit a ball. I felt that I wouldn't make the team and also felt I was not good enough like everybody else who hit the ball. I also didn't think I would do good the rest of the tryouts. I did end up making the team though. So I did not feel that much of an outcast then. Another time is when I broke my wrist. It was just before the baseball season and I felt I would fall behind. That wasn't the case though and it wasn't that bad." Mr. Sal replied, "Good evening, Joshua, your story was very inspiring. Baseball was one of my favorite sports to play when I was growing up. Your persistence paid off in the long run because you didn't give up. Sorry to hear about your broken wrist. Sometimes when our body is broken, our spirit, with the help of God heals us. I hope you keep this story for your children to read, because it will inspire them to keep trying no matter the circumstances. We don't always realize when we're out on the field that God is with us, but He is there to guide us. Say a little prayer next time you're up at bat and see what happens." We are so proud of the work all of our religious education students have completed remotely during this difficult year, and the efforts our catechists have put forth to connect with and share their faith with them.

Shortly after cleansing the temple, Jesus enters into a discourse with the Pharisee Nicodemus who comes at night to talk to him. Today's gospel is the second half of their conversation. While Nicodemus begins by stating, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God, for no one can do the signs that you are doing unless God is with him." (3:2; NABRE), it seems that Nicodemus's faith is not complete enough for Jesus. In the verses we read from today, Jesus alludes to the crucifixion, when he will be "lifted up," as well as to his identity as the savior and light of the world. In Lent we enter into a time of purification and penance. It is an apt time to ask ourselves, "In what ways have we preferred the cover of darkness to the illuminating power of the light?" We need not fear the brightness of Christ, for as St. Paul writes to the Ephesians we were brought "to life with Christ," even when we were "dead in our transgressions." God's grace is a gift offered freely and abundantly. We only need accept it.

Please do not wait until the last minute to have someone anointed. There are always accidents/emergencies, but sometimes there is less panic when the anointing can be done prior to someone passing.


