





On the feast of the Ascension we remember Jesus' words to his closest friends before he was taken up to heaven: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature." Today these words are addressed to us as the members of the Body of Christ alive in the world. For the apostles, this commissioning meant introducing people to the person of the risen Lord, the vast majority of which had never heard the name Jesus of Nazareth. As they walked this path, the apostles met with persecution and (for almost all of them) eventually martyrdom. In a way, for those of us who live in countries where Christianity is a protected religion, our journey as disciples doesn't seem anywhere near as difficult or dangerous. Jesus has called us to witness to his life, death, and resurrection. Our words about his love that is stronger than hatred and his light that is stronger than darkness will mean nothing if they are not also echoed in the way we live our lives.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We, the diocesan bishops of Illinois, write to you on an important matter of public policy and social justice. As many of you know, four years ago Democrats and Republicans worked together to pass the Invest in Kids Act on a bipartisan vote. This law allows for a 75% state income tax credit for any charitable donation to an approved scholarship granting organization (SGO). These SGOs use those donations to grant tuition scholarships to the children of working class families, whose income is no greater than three times the poverty level so that they may attend the school of their choice.

Over the past three years, the Invest in Kids program has proven to be a resounding success. Working with our partner SGOS—Empower Illinois and Big Shoulders—over 20,000 children in Illinois, from diverse racial and religious backgrounds, have been able to access some 650 different schools of their families' choice. Participating schools have provided excellent education to these students, even during the pandemic, through in-school high-quality instruction. And the need is still not being met. Already in 2021, there are over 25,000 more students waiting in line for scholarships, a testament to the need to expand this program.

Unfortunately, Governor Pritzker has recommended severely cutting the Invest in Kids program. If his budget recommendation is enacted, the program will struggle to remain viable.

We are writing to urge you to support an alternative plan which includes 1) scholarships to trade schools, 2) an increase in the Invest in Kids tax credit, and 3) annual renewals for scholarship students. We ask you to oppose the Governor's plan and join us. Support this plan which will not only benefit families in our Catholic schools but, more importantly, will provide otherwise unattainable educational opportunities for all working class families. All children deserve these opportunities no matter their family income. The popularity of the Invest in Kids program proves great support for this principle.

Please call your state legislators. You can find contact information for your state representative and state senator by visiting [www.ilcatholic.org](http://www.ilcatholic.org); scroll to the bottom of the page, click on "Find Your Legislator" and input your zip code and address. Because this is an issue that will be negotiated during the budget negotiating process, there is no specific bill number to give you. We ask you to simply call your state legislators and urge them to oppose the Governor's plan to cut the Invest in Kids program and instead support efforts to extend and improve the Invest in Kids Scholarship Tax Credit.

One of the most important decisions parents make is where their children will attend school. All of us concerned with the common good should advocate for greater access to excellent educational opportunities. This is at the heart of the Invest in Kids Act. Please join us in promoting this important issue with Illinois' political leadership.

To ascend means to rise above. As Jesus ascended to the Father, the apostles were looking up—frozen in time. They were given their mission: to teach the gospel to all nations and to bring all people to the knowledge of God. This mission continues today and is the mission for all of us who believe. The question in our minds may be the same as it was for the apostles on that first Ascension Day. *“How do we spread the gospel?”* The call to evangelize is not as difficult as we may think. To evangelize means to show the

Love of the Father to the world; this may be as simple as holding the hand of someone in pain or to share with their joy. It can also be traveling to a foreign place on a mission trip. Most of all, it is being open to the presence of God in our lives and to see His presence in others, guiding them to a relationship with their Creator. This can be accomplished by respecting the dignity of all creation and responding to the needs of friends and strangers alike. Random acts of kindness are spontaneous moments of doing the unexpected in order to lift the spirits of another. These actions can have a profound effect on the life of the recipient and may cause them to do likewise for others. When we reach out in simple ways, we spread the good news in power and assist in showing God’s grace. In doing so, we too rise with Christ to bring his peace and draw others to rise with us. This simple way of showing the love of God is actually easier now in the age of social distancing; it can be as simple as a phone call from the comfort of our homes. It is amazing what a difference a call can make. This is especially true for those who are alone, elderly, or just need some adult conversation after caring for their children all day. Letting others know that we are all in the same situation and sharing what we are doing to keep busy and trying to cope can be the difference between depression and having hope because someone cares about us. God’s presence is usually felt in subtle ways and we only realize the power of it after the encounter has happened and we consider what has been done for us.

**Baptism Information:** Baptisms are celebrated on the second & fourth Sunday of each month. A pre-Baptism program must be attended by the parents. Please call the rectory to register for a program.

**Marriage Information:** Please call the rectory to make arrangements at least six months (a year is preferred) in advance of the wedding date. It is recommended you do not rent reception facilities until your wedding date is confirmed with the pastor. Your preferred wedding date may be unavailable, and we do not want you to lose your deposit with the reception venue.

**Parish Registration:** New families are welcome and are asked to register at the rectory. Also, previously registered parishioners are asked to notify us of any address changes.

**Emergency Sick or Anointing Calls:** Please notify us immediately of any serious illness in your family. If you have a hospitalized loved one who would like a visit, please call the rectory with contact information since the hospitals and hospices no longer notify parishes. Please do not wait until the last minute to have someone anointed. There are always accidents/emergencies, but sometimes there is less panic when the anointing can be done prior to someone passing.


