

In today's gospel Jesus speaks the words of the baptismal formula that, since then, have been used for millennia to usher men, women, and children into the life of God. The threefold gift of water is to be imparted *"in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."* On this feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we pause to reflect on the mystery of "Trinity" not as a way of *thinking* about God, but as our Christian way of *knowing* God. All theology is rooted in our experience of God, and this is true for the doctrine of the Trinity as well. In her book *Quest for the Living God*, theologian Elizabeth

Johnson describes how the early Christian community of the New Testament knew *"the saving God in a threefold way as beyond them, with them and within them that is, as utterly transcendent, as present historically in the person of Jesus, and as present in the Spirit within their community. These were all encounters with only one God."* In the Trinity we experience God as a continuous outpouring of love, and in our baptism we have been welcomed into the dynamic dance of grace that occurs between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In the first reading from the book of Deuteronomy, Moses enjoins the people to *"fix in your heart, that the Lord is God in the heavens above and on earth below, and that there is no other."* Above all, God desires a wholehearted relationship with us that requires our active participation and fidelity. We, too, are called to "fix in [our] hearts" our understanding of God as the one who creates, redeems and sanctifies us and then sends us forth to bear his life to others.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity, our Triune Godhead, is one that has eluded thinkers and theologians since the early days of the Church. As we try to comprehend this reality of God, we too are at a loss for words for it is truly beyond anything of this world. Human experience does not have a reference point to compare with this understanding of God. St. Patrick used the shamrock, with each shoot having three leaves making up one part of the plant to explain to the Celts the threeness of the one true God.

Another interpretation is that the one God is our creator, redeemer, and sanctifier. God created us and all that exist to love him and His creation to the best of our ability. However, from the accounts of the Old Testament, man showed that this was not always possible. In order to help us enter into God's love more deeply, he sent his son to show us in our world the way to the Father. After Jesus finished his mission on earth God, in his wisdom, knew that mankind would still need a way to stay in union with him. He sent the Holy Spirit who descended on the Apostles and, through the giving of His gifts, we are given the necessary attributes to remain faithful to God. This is the one we adore for our God continues to pour forth his grace and love on his creation through the redemptive actions of his only son and guides us to eternal union with him through the Holy Spirit.

Go!

In Matthew's gospel, the last words of Jesus to the disciples before ascending have three key elements: go, baptize, I'm with you. Therefore, living after the resurrection of Jesus means three things:

- (1) Do not stay where it is safe; shed your doubt; go everywhere to everyone.
- (2) Baptizing into and teaching about resurrected life go together. That is why the baptismal catechumenate (RCIA) always spends so much time and effort in formation before an Easter Vigil. Time with parents and their babies, too.
- (3) We are not alone. Matthew ends with Jesus declaring, "I am with you always" just as this gospel began with the Virgin's birth of Emmanuel (God is with us).
 - ◆ *What doubt do I have about God, about belief, about Church, about living in this world? Where can I turn?*
 - ◆ *What ongoing formation in baptismal living do I need now?*
 - ◆ *To whom am I called to "go"—someone to be with, to do for?*

To know what is right and not to do it is the worst cowardice. (Confucius)



Baptism Information: Baptisms are celebrated on the second & fourth Sunday of each month. A pre-Baptism program must be attended by the parents. Please call the rectory to register for a program.

Marriage Information: Please call the rectory to make arrangements at least six months (a year is preferred) in advance of the wedding date. It is recommended you do not rent reception facilities until your wedding date is confirmed with the pastor. Your preferred wedding date may be unavailable, and we do not want you to lose your deposit with the reception venue.


