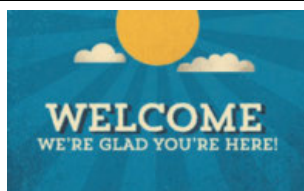

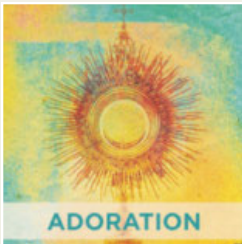

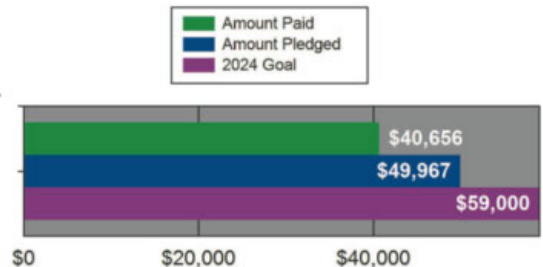

Last week's article detailed the events at what is now known as the Duquesne Weekend. Today, we explore "Life in the Spirit" further.

After that weekend, news of what had occurred spread rapidly since those who had attended had been so touched by the Spirit they had suddenly grown in their understanding of what God was doing in their lives. They had experienced personal conversion, and felt compelled to go forth and share the message of a "Catholic Charismatic Renewal."

As time passed, the Holy Spirit continued to inspire new communities and movements with diverse expressions of prayer, missions, and use of various "charismatic" gifts. Huge stadium-filling crowds attended events at the University of Notre Dame, Michigan State, and the University of Michigan as well as in other parts of the United States.

"Baptism in the Holy Spirit" helped those who were touched to facilitate the use of their "charisms" to their fullest potential. The renewal spread throughout the world. Pope St. John Paul II was an enthusiastic supporter, and soon after becoming Pope said "I am convinced that this movement is a sign of the Spirit's action...a very important component in the total renewal of the Church."

In 1984, *A Pastoral Statement on the Catholic Charismatic Renewal* was issued, concluding: "... baptism in the Holy Spirit makes Jesus Christ known and loved as Lord and Savior, establishes or reestablishes an immediacy of relationship with all those persons on the Trinity, and through inner transformation affects the whole of the Christian's life. There is new life and a new conscious awareness of God's power and presence. It is a grace experience which touches every dimension of the Church's life: worship, preaching, teaching, ministry, evangelism, prayer and spirituality, service and community. Because of this, it is our conviction that baptism in the Holy Spirit,

understood as the reawakening in Christian experience of the presence and action of the Holy Spirit given in Christian initiation, and manifested in a broad range of charisms...is part of the normal Christian life."

Next week, we'll bring you up to date on how the Holy Spirit can work more fully in your life.
