Last week's article detailed the events at what is now known as the Duquesne Weekend. Today, we explore "Life in the Spirit" further.

After that weekend, news of what had occurred spread rapidly since those who had attended had been so touched by the Spirit they had suddenly grown in their understanding of what God was doing in their lives. They had experienced personal conversion, and felt compelled to go forth and share the message of a "Catholic Charismatic Renewal."

As time passed, the Holy Spirit continued to inspire new communities and movements with diverse expressions of prayer, missions, and use of various "charismatic" gifts. Huge stadium-filling crowds attended events at the University of Notre Dame, Michigan State, and the University of Michigan as well as in other parts of the United States.

"Baptism in the Holy Spirit" helped those who were touched to facilitate the use of their "charisms" to their fullest potential. The renewal spread throughout the world. Pope St. John Paul II was an enthusiastic supporter, and soon after becoming Pope said "I am convinced that this movement is a sign of the Spirit's action...a very important component in the total renewal of the Church."

In 1984, A Pastoral Statement on the Catholic Charismatic Renewal was issued, concluding: "... baptism in the Holy Spirit makes Jesus Christ known and loved as Lord and Savior, establishes or reestablishes an immediacy of relationship with all those persons on the Trinity, and through inner transformation affects the whole of the Christian's life. There is new life and a new conscious awareness of God's power and presence. It is a grace experience which touches every dimension of the Church's life: worship, preaching, teaching, ministry, evangelism, prayer and spirituality, service and community. Because of this, it is our conviction that baptism in the Holy Spirit,

Baptism Information: Baptisms are celebrated on the second & fourth Sunday of each month. A pre-Baptism program must be attended by the parents. Please call the rectory to register for a program.

Marriage Information: Please call the rectory to make arrangements at least six months (a year is preferred) in advance of the wedding date. It is recommended yoù do not rent reception facilities until your wedding date is confirmed with the pastor. Your preferred wedding date may be unavailable, and we do not want you to lose your deposit with the reception venue.

Parish Registration: New families are welcome and are asked to register at the rectory. Also, previously registered parishioners are asked to notify us of any address changes.

Liturgical Ministries: We need men, women, and children to become Lectors, Communion Ministers, Ushers, and Altar Servers. Please contact Deacon Philip Heitz, OFS if you are interested.

Emergency Sick or Anointing Calls: Please notify us immediately of any serious illness in your family. If you have a hospitalized loved one who would like a visit, please call the rectory with contact information since the hospitals and hospices no longer notify parishes. Please do not wait until the last minute to have someone anointed. There are always accidents/emergencies, but sometimes there is less panic when the anointing can be done prior to someone passing.

We have low-gluten hosts available which make it possible for people who have celiac disease or allergies to wheat or gluten to be able to receive communion. If you have celiac disease or an allergy to wheat or gluten, please let us know before Mass so that arrangements can be made for you to be able to receive communion at Mass.




