



Divine Mercy Sunday

Church for Benediction of the Blessed
Sacrament and Chaplet of Divine
Mercy. You can also receive a gift of
the Pardon Crucifix. Jesus told St.

Faustina Kowalska, "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. The soul that will go to confess on eight days before or eight days after and receive Holy Communion on that day shall obtain complete forgiveness of their sins and punishment due to their sins." In 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and established Divine Mercy Sunday for the universal church. He died on April 2, 2005, on Saturday, the day before Divine Mercy Sunday. "The greater the sinner, the greater the right they have to my mercy." (From the diary of St. Faustina Kowalska)



Today we celebrate one of the more recent additions to our Liturgical calendar. In the Jubilee Year 2000, St. Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina Kowalska, and declared that the Sunday after Easter be called Divine Mercy Sunday.

St. Faustina was a Polish nun favored by visions from Jesus including one of His wearing a white garment with beams of red and white coming from His heart. Our church building has a copy of that image located to the organ side of the altar.

St. Faustina kept a diary, and in it she wrote that Jesus had said to her "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy."

According to her recorded vision, all who receive communion and attend confession on the Feast of Mercy will receive total forgiveness of sins.

In his homily during the saint's canonization Pope St. John Paul II stated, "Divine Mercy reaches human beings through the heart of Christ crucified." He explained the image's two rays as representing blood and water that reflected the blood and water that flowed from Jesus' side when He was speared on the cross. The blood recalls Christ's sacrifice and the gift of the Eucharist, and the water represents not only Baptism, but also the gift of the Holy Spirit.

It's always consoling to realize the extent of God's merciful kindness to us. No matter the sin, no matter the issue, no matter the difficulty, God is still the loving Father, Savior, and Sanctifier. God will never let us down, and will give us the peace and tranquility we all deeply desire if we only give God a chance to shower Divine Mercy upon us.



Baptism Information: Baptisms are celebrated on the second & fourth Sunday of each month. A pre-Baptism program must be attended by the parents. Please call the rectory to register for a program.

Marriage Information: Please call the rectory to make arrangements at least six months (a year is preferred) in advance of the wedding date. It is recommended you do not rent reception facilities until your wedding date is confirmed with the pastor. Your preferred wedding date may be unavailable, and we do not want you to lose your deposit with the reception venue.

Parish Registration: New families are welcome and are asked to register at the rectory. Also, previously registered parishioners are asked to notify us of any address changes.

Please do not wait until the last minute to have someone anointed. There are always accidents/emergencies, but sometimes there is less panic when the anointing can be done prior to someone passing.

If you have celiac disease or an allergy to wheat or gluten, please let us know before Mass so that arrangements can be made for you to be able to receive communion at Mass.
